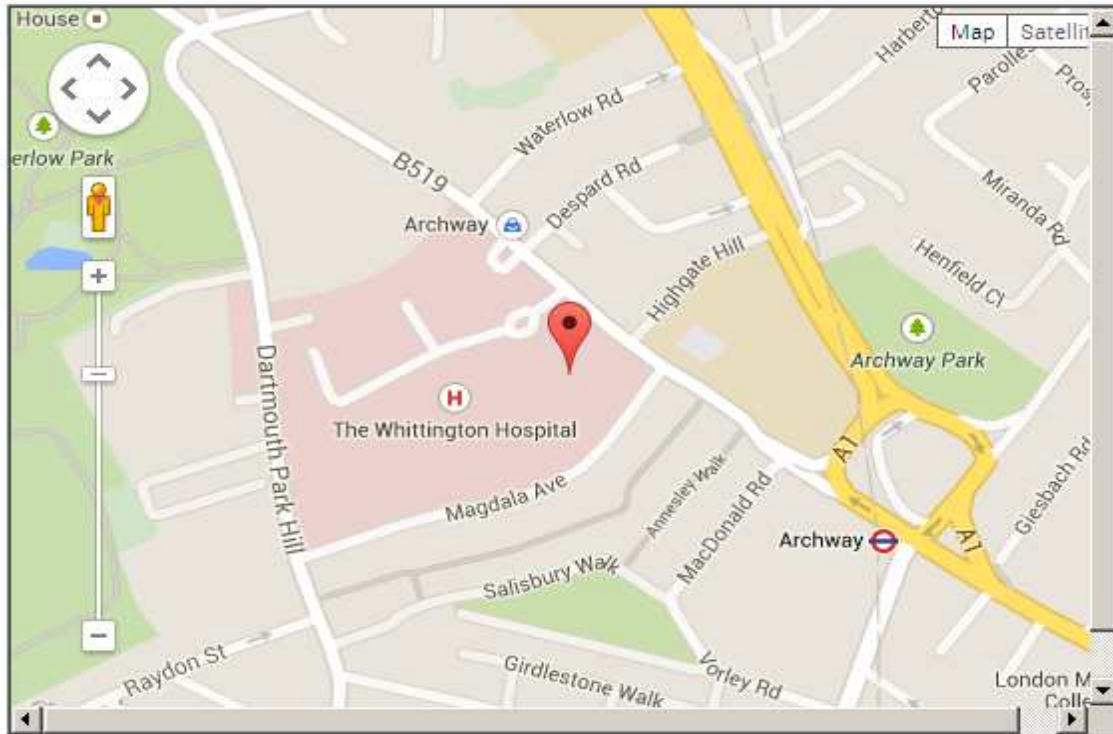

INDUCTION WEEK (WEEK 1 & 2)

Details of your induction programme will be provided to you upon joining. However please note that all new employees must complete all elements of the Whittington Health Corporate Induction as well as a local induction at their place of work. The Corporate Induction consists of face to face and e-learning elements covering the new starter in terms of their core mandatory training requirements. E-learning modules must be completed during the first week and face to face training within four weeks of starting work for Whittington Health.

New staff will have received their username and password to access e-learning together with their offer letter.

(WH) LIBRARY SERVICE

WH Library Service offers a friendly, comprehensive and modern library service to all staff working for the Whittington Health Trust, both on site or in the community. Your Trust ID card is your Library card and with it you'll be able to borrow up to 6 books. The Library provides you with access to 6 Trust PCs, 8 laptops and Trust wifi. Please note that your first pay day will be on 27th of October 2015; please ensure that you have enough money for cost of living until then.

NATIONAL INSURANCE NUMBER

National Insurance is paid by every working individual in the UK. You need to arrange an appointment to obtain a National Insurance (NI) Number: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-national-insurance-number>

The Department of Social Security will advise what you'll need to take with you to your appointment. The whole procedure usually takes 6-8 weeks before arriving by post. They will need confirmation that you are living in the UK and that you are employed.

REGISTERING WITH A DOCTOR and DENTIST

The NHS is the UK's public health system, providing free medical treatment for millions of people every year. You are eligible for free NHS treatment. To register with a doctor you can obtain a list of your local GPs from NHS website: <http://www.nhs.uk/Service-Search/GP/LocationSearch/4direct>
Once you have registered with a doctor, register with a local dentist as soon as possible. First of all, make sure that the dentist accepts NHS patients – some dentists only accept private patients.

TRAVEL & OYSTER CARD

Oyster is a smartcard which can hold pay as you go credit, Travelcard and Bus & Tram Pass season tickets. Use it to travel on bus, Tube, Tram, DLR, London Overground and most National Rail services in London.

With an Oyster Card you can top up with pay as you go credit or renew your Travelcard or Bus & Tram Pass on the same Oyster card when you need to. If you keep both pay as you go credit and a Travelcard or Bus & Tram Pass on your Oyster card at the same time, it works out which one to use to make sure you never pay more than you need.

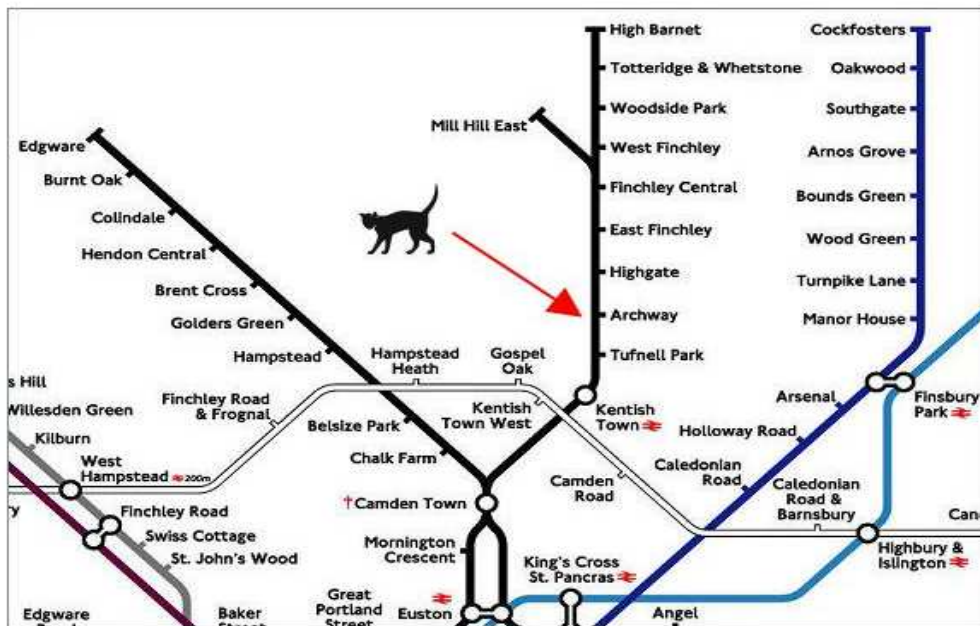
When you get a new Oyster card, you'll need to pay a **£5 deposit**. If you decide you don't need it anymore, return your Oyster card to us and we'll refund your deposit.
