## Chatterpillars.... A guide to your child's placement

Chatterpillars is a package of weekly speech and language therapy and Parent Training for ONE TERM, **normally 10 weeks**, run by Children's Community Health Services, part of Whittington Health NHS Trust

### What support will my child and I receive?

- A weekly therapy session run by the Speech and Language Therapists Kahina Khamache and Alice Towler. Groups run every Wednesday morning from either 9.30am-10.45 **OR** 10.45am – 12.00pm for ONE term only and are held at *Triangle Children's Centre* – see 1. on map
- A parent only workshop is held on the Wednesday morning a week before the start of the block (no crèche provided). Parents are encouraged to be actively involved in the placement e.g. to attend the parent session and to try out the activities and strategies at home

### How many children will be in the programme?

Each terms' intake is for 6 children per group who have severe language difficulties. All the children are aged between 3 and 5 years old. Children attending Chatterpillars will have previously attended a block of Speech & Language Therapy in clinic.



## What happens at the end of the placement?

At the end of the term the Speech & Language Therapist will discuss future management of your child's Speech & Language Therapy with you and feedback progress to school in a form of a communication profile.
