

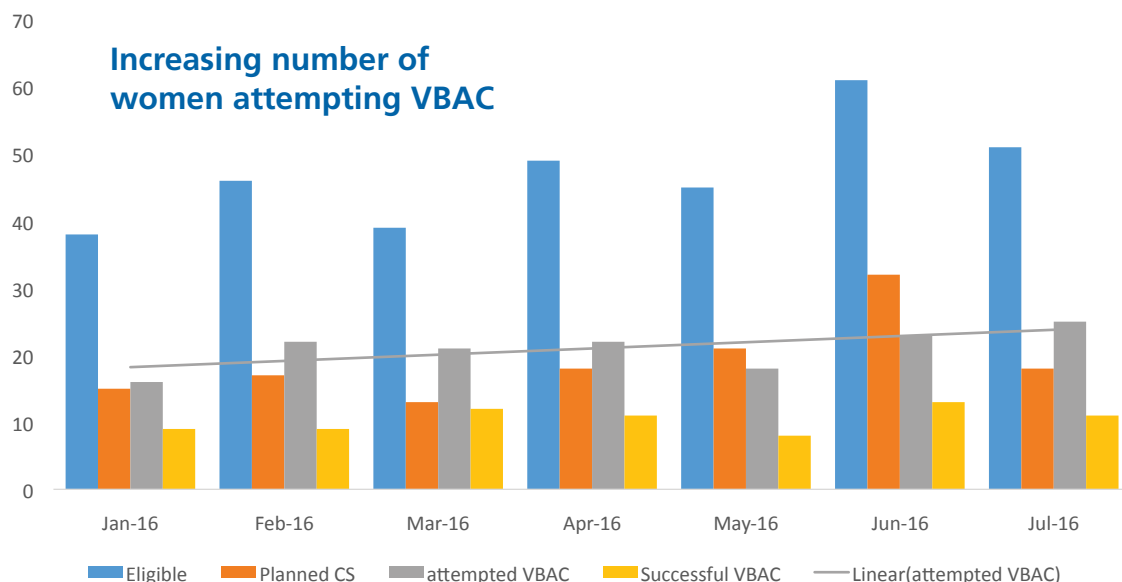

Vaginal Birth After Caesarean (VBAC)

If you have a baby by caesarean, it doesn't necessarily mean that any babies you have in the future will also have to be delivered this way. Most women who have had a caesarean section can safely have a vaginal delivery for their next baby, known as Vaginal Birth After Caesarean (VBAC). However, you may need some extra monitoring during labour just to make sure everything is progressing well.

 - Average rate* of women in **England** who have a VBAC following a Caesarean Section is **27.9%**
