Why am I having a medical check up?

To check that you are healthy and well.

Where does it happen?

At the paediatric assessment unit at St Ann's Hospital.

What happens?

You will see a children's doctor (paediatrician) who will check your height and weight and see if you are healthy. The doctor will ask if it is alright before they do this.

You can choose who you would like to have with you.



Waiting to see the doctor

There are toys for you to play with. You can choose a drink and a snack to eat.



Don't worry, the doctor won't do anything that hurts you and there won't be any injections.
