	 The strategy advocates setting up delivery units to manage sustainable development in 5 keys areas. These are; Energy and Carbon Procurement and Food Travel and Transport Water Waste 		
	Capital investment has been identified of £1.2m over the 5 years of the strategy and shows potential savings of 1,143 tonnes of Carbon Dioxide per year at the end of year 5. This arises from reduced consumption of;		
	 Electricity - 1,133,843 kWh (per year at the end of year 5) Gas - 2,669,903 kWh (per year at the end of year 5) 		
	Based on April 09 prices this represents an annual saving of :-		
	 Electricity - £ 92,975 (per year at the end of year 5) Gas - £ 46,723 (per year at the end of year 5) 		
	Delivery of the strategy will be performance managed through the Carbon Reduction Strategy Group and reported to the Trust Executive Committee half yearly. An annual report will be made to the trust board in the June of each year.
