

Appendix 3a same sex monitoring

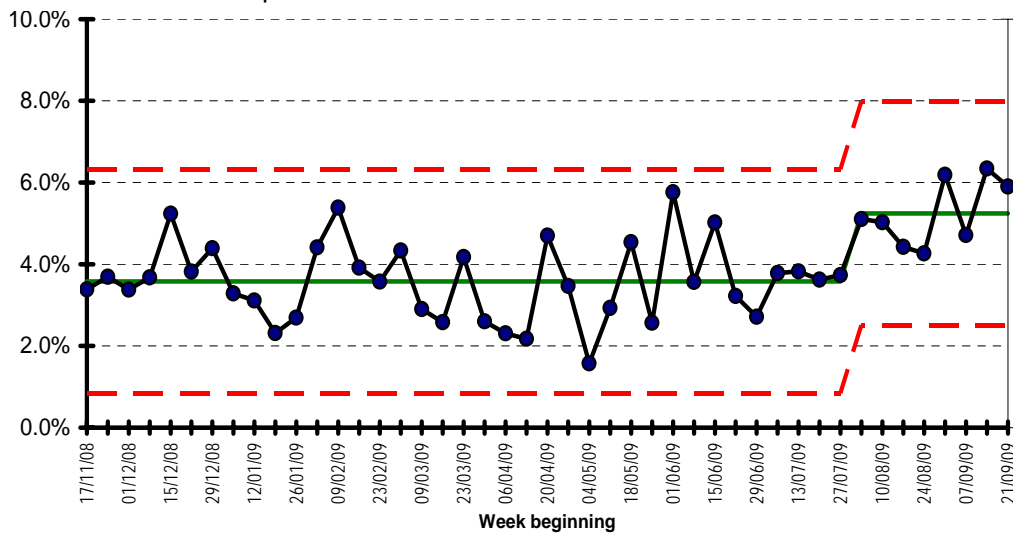
1. There were 818 same sex breaches in Q2. This represents an increase in breaches over Q1. However the increase is directly linked to the constraints the hospital has faced during the summer when wards were decanted to enable the program of works to be completed to enable full compliance from October. The final ward redevelopment will complete at the end of this month. All wards will then have full segregation of bedroom and bathroom facilities. All nightingale type wards will be fully single sex.

The Whittington monitors actual single sex breaches and reports performance to Trust Board on a monthly basis. Fig 1. below is the report that the Trust Board receives through the dashboard.

Fig 1 . Single sex accommodation

Each patient counts as a breach for each day that the mixed sex breach occurs
Total breach days as a Percentage of occupied bed days in week.
