The Committee felt that there is still much work to do to embed integrated risk management across the Trust. It emphasised its intention to continue to monitor the implementation of risk management in the divisions, thus complementing the Quality Committee's ongoing focus on the management of substantive clinical risks. Debriefed Ernst & Young (E&Y), following their recent engagement with the Trust, to gain an additional independent perspective on the most important risks that the trust face going forward.
